

Dear South Campus Commons and Courtyards residents,

We are writing to follow up on [Governor Hogan's executive order to Stay-at-Home](#) effective today, March 30 at 8:00pm for the State of Maryland. The order requires all persons in the State of Maryland to remain at home unless they are conducting essential activities.

- We've received guidance that students who are currently on campus but are scheduled to return to their permanent address or other off-campus location between now and April 5th are still able to do so and should continue with those plans. Please see [CDC guidelines](#) for recommended social distancing practices while you complete your move-out.
- If you are currently present at South Campus Commons or The Courtyards and cannot leave to go home, you must apply for emergency housing* as soon as possible if you have not done so already.

*Please note:

- students remaining at SCC and CTY emergency housing will be billed a daily rate until you officially check out and return your keys.
- We will have limited students remaining in emergency, on-campus housing and there will be very limited services available during this time.

- If you are currently living on-campus, please take note of the requirements of the stay-at-home order and continue to follow required [social distancing and prevention measures](#). You must continue following [CDC guidelines](#) for social distancing. NOTE: Gatherings of 10 or more people are prohibited. The governor announced today "A person who knowingly and willfully violates this Order is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding one year or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both"
- If you are currently away from campus, please stay home until the stay-at-home order has been lifted.
- Residents returning to the same bed for fall 2020 will be allowed to leave only personal belongings in the current bedroom. You will be required to fill out a waiver form which will be sent in the coming week.
